## **Publicis Loyalty EBA Consultation to commence.**

As most of you would be aware the current Publicis Loyalty Workplace Relationship Agreement (EBA) is due to expire on the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2010. Now is the time to meet with all staff to gain input from you as to what conditions you would like to see changed in the current EBA, or conditions currently not in the EBA you would like to see added.

The ASU will also be updating staff in relation to the changes in the new Workplace Relations Laws and the impact these will have on this round of negotiations with Publicis Loyalty

The aim of commencing discussions with all staff now is to ensure all staff have an opportunity to provide their feedback. The ASU and your Delegates will then collate these responses and this will formulate the "Log of Claims" that will be put to Publicis Loyalty Management.

The ASU and your Delegates are keen to begin the EBA negotiation in early March to allow the maximum time to reach agreement and have the new EBA in place prior to the June expiry of the current EBA so there can be a smooth transition on to the new EBA.

### ***We need to know what it is you would like in your new EBA.***

It is vital that all staff have the opportunity to put forward their suggestions for the new EBA, so we have arranged with Publicis Loyalty Management to hold consultation meetings on the following days :

***Tuesday the 23<sup>rd</sup> of February.***

***Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup> of February.***

***Friday the 26<sup>th</sup> of February.***

***All meetings will be paid time meetings.***

All staff are being rostered to attend on one of these meetings and if you are unsure as to what time you should be attending please speak with your team leader.

If you will not be at work on one of these days, it is still important that you have the opportunity to be updated about the new workplace laws and get the chance to raise what you would like in the EBA.
