It's time for a new ASU agreement at Rex!

The Regional Express (Rex) Airline Services Collective Agreement 2008 is due to expire on 30 June 2008.

This doesn't mean that it no longer applies, but it does mean that until a new agreement is negotiated there will no further increase in your wages or allowances.

What is in the Agreement?

Your Agreement contains the conditions under which you are employed. These include your hours of work, shift conditions, classification structure, rates of pay, share gift, overtime and holidays, to name a few.

Who negotiates the new agreement?

Your Union, the Australian Services Union (ASU) negotiates the agreement with management of Rex. The ASU have trained Delegates who represent their work areas at the bargaining table to directly represent your views.

How can you have a say?

All ASU members in Rex around the country will have the opportunity to have their voices heard. ASU Organisers will be visiting work sites to meet with members and discuss their issues over the next few weeks.
