TABCORP EBA Negotiations to commence.

As most of you would be aware the current TABCORP EBA failed to pass through the Workplace Authority. The ASU have been working with TABCORP to resolve the issues. In spite of this TABCORP have now taken the disappointing position that it will not make the payment to all Operators of the final wage increase that was due on the 1st of July 2009.

TABCORP and the ASU have agreed to commence negotiations for a new Agreement to resolve the current situation, and to this end we now seek your feedback.

We need to know what it is you would like in your new EBA.

It is vital that all staff have the opportunity to put forward their suggestions for the new EBA, whether current members or not. So please take the time to complete the short survey below so that we can formulate the list of claims to be taken to the Company for negotiation.
