

# Employment Services: not just a job – launch of industry survey and resources

The ASU has been funded by the Department of Education Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) to undertake a national Employment Service Worker Reconnection project. This project will investigate issues relating to the migration of workers from Job Network providers to Job Services Australia (JSA) providers and the attraction and retention of a skilled workforce for JSA. The ASU is calling this project *Employment Services: not just a job*.
